

As of 2024, the neonatal mortality rate (NMR) in India stands at approximately 18.1 deaths per 1,000 live births. This figure reflects ongoing efforts to reduce infant mortality, though challenges remain, particularly in rural areas and among economically disadvantaged populations. Neonatal resuscitation when implemented systematically by trained personnel can reduce significant number of neonatal deaths, so it is imperative to train health care personals. The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) Training of Trainers (TOT) Basic Instructor Course is designed to equip healthcare professionals with the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively teach neonatal resuscitation techniques. The course emphasizes the importance of rapid, accurate assessment and intervention in neonatal emergencies to improve outcomes for newborns.

- Chest compression and medications.

- Simulation-based training and debriefing techniques.

Hands-on Training:

- Participants engaged in various practical sessions using neonatal manikins.
- Scenarios included resuscitation of a term newborn, management of a preterm newborn, and complex resuscitation situations.

Methods of Instruction:

 Combination of lectures, practical demonstrations, interactive discussions, and simulation-based training.

Assessment Methods:

- Pre-course knowledge assessment.
- Practical skills assessment during hands-on sessions.



Aim of Activity:

The activity aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application by providing a simulated learning environment. It sought to create a safe space for the students to practice medical surgical skills, receive expert guidance, and gain confidence in their abilities

Objective of simulation based workshop:

The primary objective of the training program was to equip the nursing students with the necessary knowledge and skills to effectively handle emergency patient it aimed to:

- Enhance their knowledge and understanding of ACLS/BLS/PALS
- · Familiarize them with the correct techniques and procedures for various emergency procedures.
- Provide them with ample opportunities for practice and skill development.
- Foster their critical thinking and decision-making abilities in Mega code scenario based practice scenarios.

Overview

The Medical Surgical Nursing Department organizes two days' workshop on ACLS/BLS/PLS program for Diploma, Graduates and Postgraduate students. Total 100 students and 50 faculties were enrolled for this workshop. It was a comprehensive initiative to improve their skill during emergency management. The program focused on providing hands-on experience in a simulated environment, allowing students to develop competence and confidence in performing various medical surgical lifesaving procedures such as cardiopulmonary resuscitation, advance cardiac life support and paediatric life support.

The training program aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application by offering a realistic and controlled learning environment. By engaging in simulated scenarios, students were able to gain practical experience without compromising patient safety.

The program was initiate with welcome address of organizing Secretary Mrs. Manorama Kashyap Prof. vishakha Ganvir was the chairperson of the programme. There after it proceeds with the lighting the lamp by dignitaries of workshop. Latter on it; felicitation of resource person Mr. Swapnil Rahane certified (AHA Instructor) Parul institute of nursing.

DAY 1 (03/10/2023) - Workshop started with knowledge based Pre-test questionnaire latter on proceeds with lecture on basic life support and use of automated external defibrillator (AED) along with cardiac Arrest Algorithm Practice. Both resources Person gave hands on practice for each topic to every student and faculty to give their relevance in nursing practice and their significance in patient care.

By participating in the program, the students had the opportunity to enhance their understanding of medical surgical concepts and principles. They learned about the post cardiac care, paediatric life support, Airways Management, (AMBU BAG MASK) and the day one ends with debriefing session.

DAY 2 (04/10/2023) the program schedule was carefully planned to include both theoretical lectures and practical sessions. The second day starts with the session on post cardiac care; tachycardia and Bradycardia algorithm Practice along with management chocking and reversible causes of cardiac arrest. Latter on session proceeds with Mega code Scenario based practice. The practical sessions included live demonstrations and hands-on practice, allowing the students to apply their knowledge in a simulated setting.


Day 2 ends with post-test and valedictory function.


