Every year, 1st December is observed as World AIDS Day to create public awareness about HIV/AIDS prevention, causes, transmission and stigma-free society. On this occasion, the youth red cross organized an awareness programme at Civil Hospital, Jalgaon to educate the community and motivate people for healthy and safe practices.

The large number of participants reflected collective responsibility and dedication towards AIDS awareness.

The program started with a formal inauguration ceremony, graced by respected medical officers, faculty members from nursing colleges, and invited dignitaries. As a symbolic gesture of spreading hope and awareness, red balloons were released into the sky during the inauguration.

A large rally was organised to spread mass awareness among the public.

- The rally started from Civil Hospital premises and moved through nearby areas.
- Students held posters, banners, and placards displaying slogans related to AIDS awareness, prevention, and support for HIV-positive individuals.
- A large number of students from different nursing colleges participated, making the rally highly impactful.

To make the message more understandable for the general public, students of MBBS performed a play inside the Civil Hospital campus.

- The act highlighted how HIV spreads, how it does NOT spread, and the importance of safe practices.
- Myths and stigma related to HIV/AIDS were effectively addressed.
- The message that AIDS is not transmitted through casual contact and society must support HIV-positive individuals was strongly conveyed.
