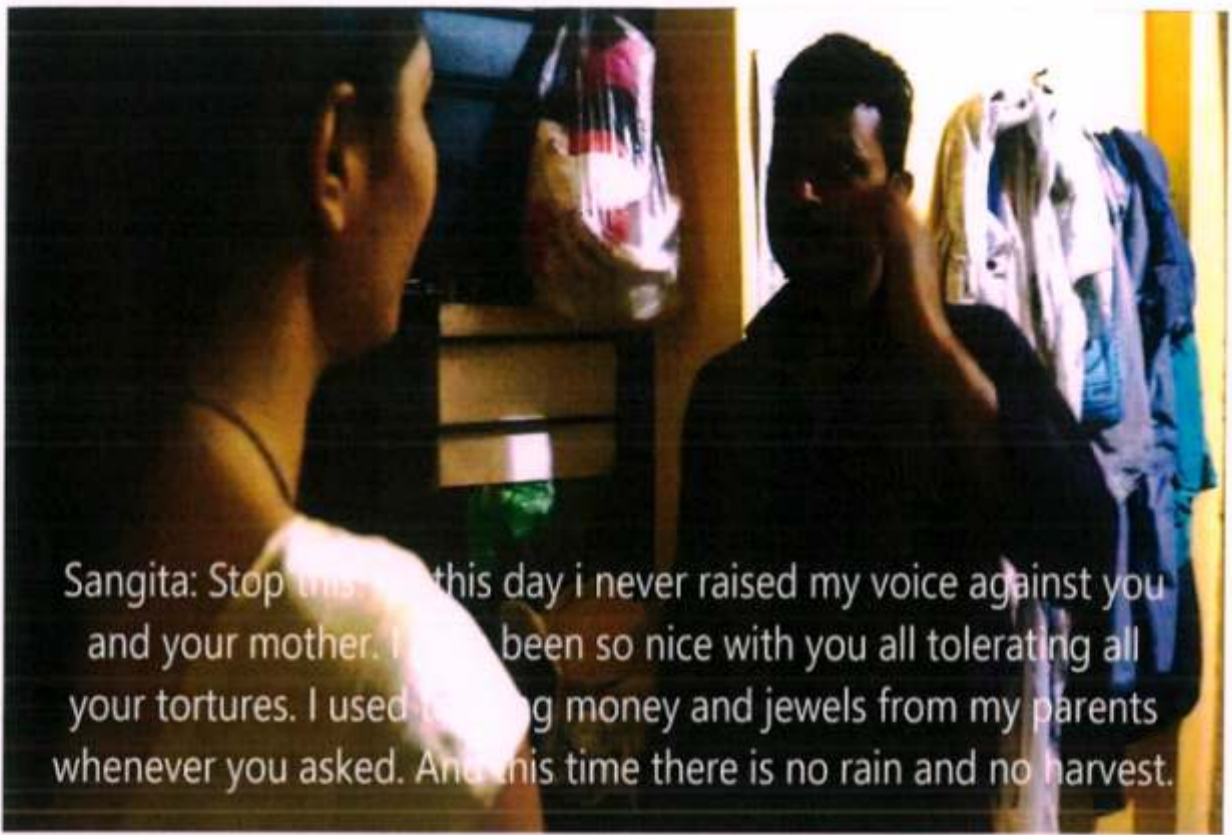

The participants for this video was students of GNM third year. The objective of the programme was achieved successfully.

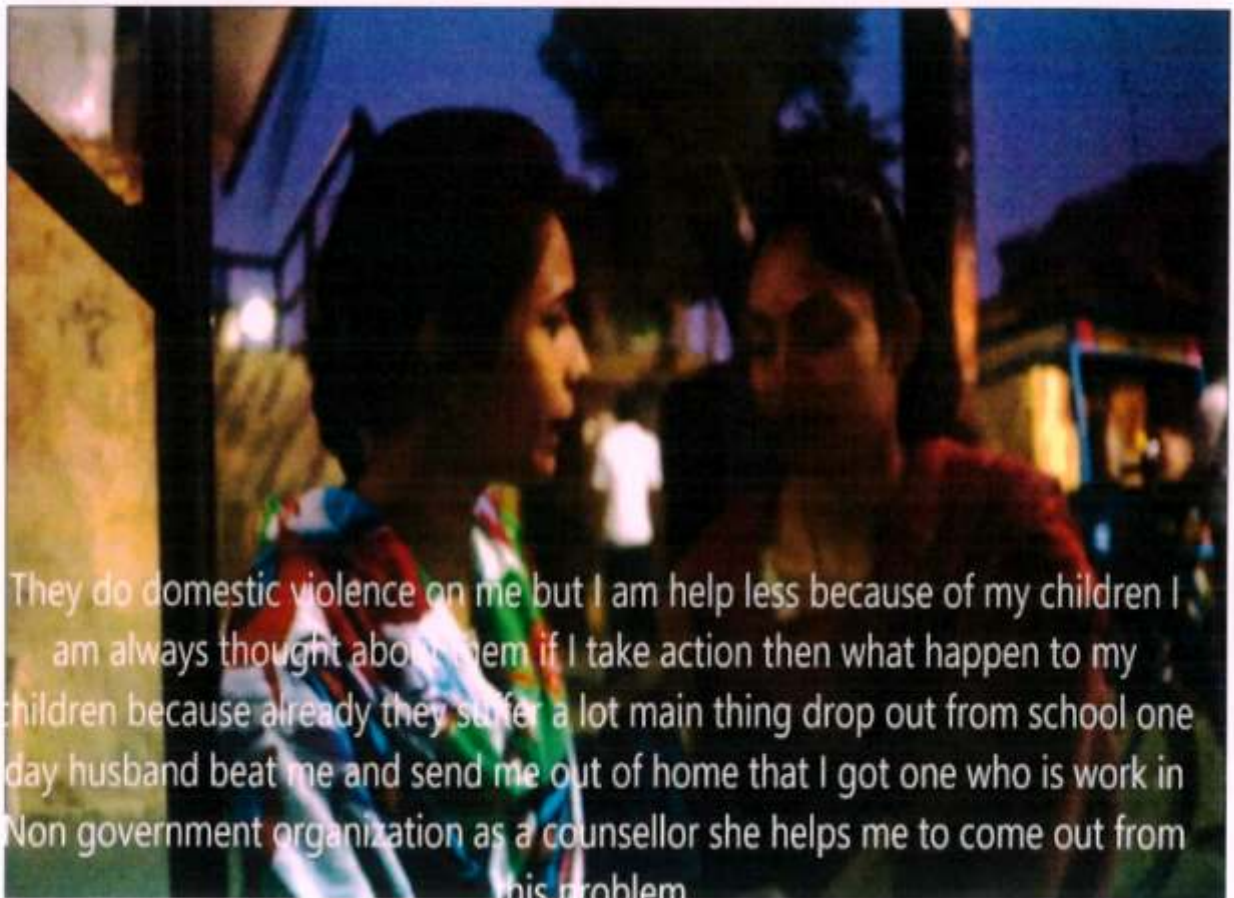

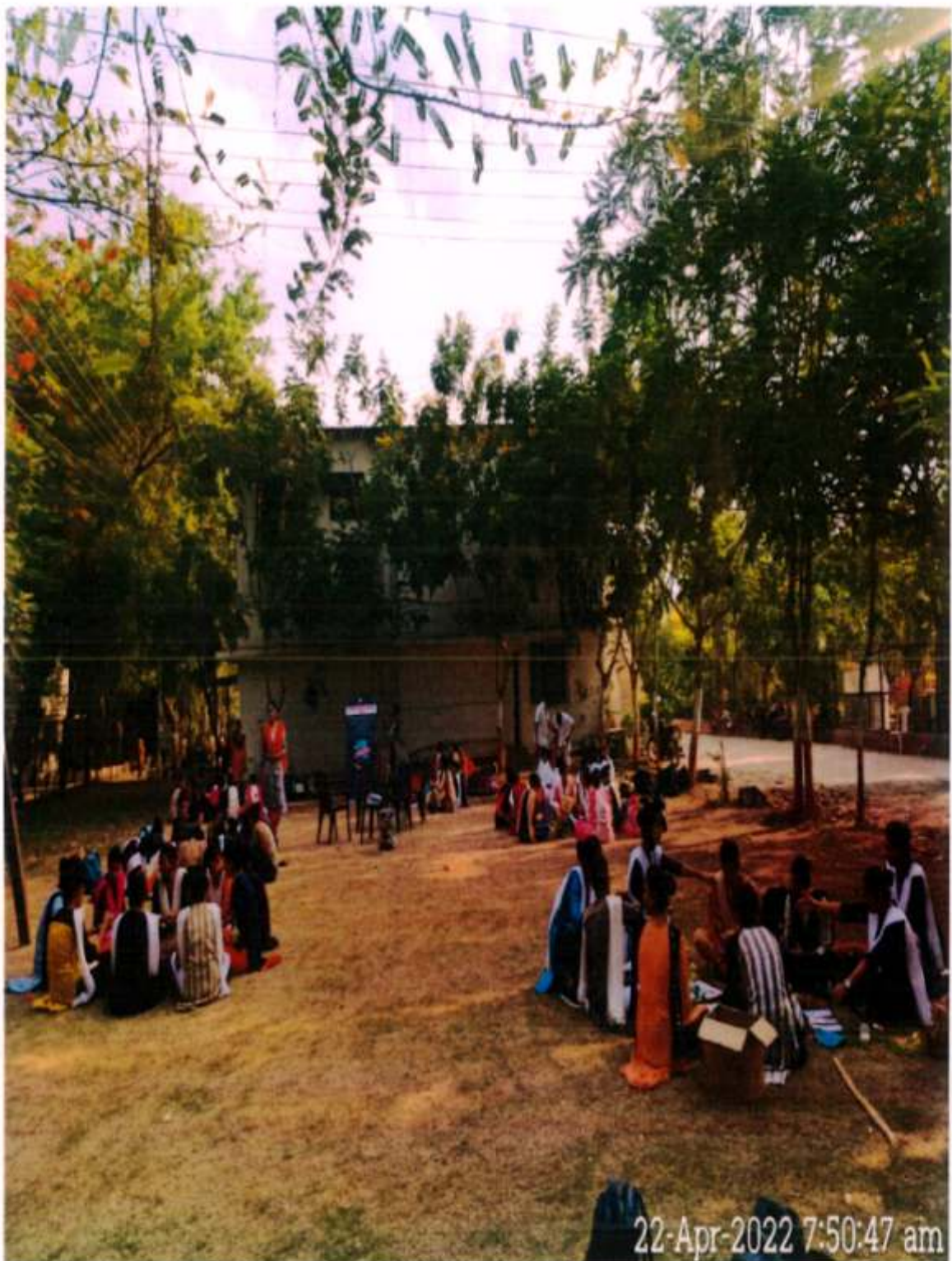


Fig 4 . All Student's Active Participates In Tree Plantation Activity

OBJECTIVE:


