The students of Godavari College of Nursing, guided by NSS Coordinator Mrs.Nimmi Varghese, organized a comprehensive NSS camp in Nashirabad from 9<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2024. This camp focused on health education, social awareness, and community development through engaging activities aimed at addressing various critical issues.

#### Day 1: Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (9th September 2024)

The camp kicked off with a cleanliness drive at the Primary Health Centre, Nashirabad. Students actively participated in cleaning efforts, emphasizing the importance of hygiene in public spaces. #### Conclusion


