- 1. Achieve universal access to high-quality care for all people with TB
- 2. Reduce the human suffering and socioeconomic burden associated with TB
- 3. Protect vulnerable populations from TB, TB/HIV and multidrug-resistant TB
- 4. Support development of new tools and enable their timely and effective use

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Protect and promote human rights in TB prevention, care and control
- To provide outpatient facility for diagnosis, control, treatment of tuberculosis and to augment IEC activities in order to strengthen preventive aspect by educating the masses.
- 3. To provide outdoor patient care for patients of TB and respiratory diseases.
- 4. To promote training, teaching and research in TB.
- 5. To organize training activities for various health workers/personnel involved in the control and management of tuberculosis.
- 6. To provide specialized diagnostic and treatment facilities for tuberculosis and other respiratory diseases patients.

#### HISTORY OF WORLD TB DAY

The day aims to increase efforts to end the global epidemic of TB, one of the world's deadliest infectious killers which according to data by World Health Organisation (WHO) has claimed the lives of around 1,400,000 people in the year 2019. WHO also said that around 63 million lives have been saved since 2000 because of the global efforts against tuberculosis. "TB remains one of the world's deadliest infectious killers. Each day, nearly 4000 lose their lives to TB and close to 28,000 people fall ill with this preventable and curable disease," WHO added.

March 24 also marks the day on which Dr Robert Koch announced in 1881 that he had made the discovery of the bacterium which causes TB. This "opened the way towards diagnosing and curing this disease," said WHO in an official statement.
