



DISCRIPTIVE REPORT

The schedule of the programme as follows. The first day of the course started with registration at 9 am. The inauguration of workshop was done by Dr. Mousami Lendhe Principal GCON, Jalgaon followed by addressed to participants.

Mr. Piyush Wagh, Assistant Professor & MUHS Coordinator for Basic RM Workshop spoken about the importance of this workshop and declare the workshop to be open.

Total 50 delegates were registered for workshop of which 24 were Nursing PG's students and 17 faculty from Godavari College of Nursing, 4 faculty from Dr. Ulhas Patil Homeopathic Medical college and Hospital Jalgaon Kh, 2 PG students from Shiva Trust Aurangabad college of Nursing Bhalgaon Aurangabad, 3 PG students from Kamalnayan Bajaj Nursing college Aurangabad.

Day 1 Started with lecture by Dr Dhiraj Karala, Reader and in charge of public dentistry, YMT Dental college and Hospital Khargahar Navi Mumbai Sir delivered lecture on introduction to research methodology followed by session on descriptive study design by Dr. Kiran Tawlare

After the short break Dr. Vijay Singh Professor Dept. Of Community Medicine L.T.M. Medical College & General hospital, Sion, Mumbai has delivered a lecture on case control and cohort studies and evaluation on diagnostic test later on the next lecture conducted by Dr. Kalpana Talware Asso. Prof, BAMS MD (Rachana Sharir) PhD (Scho) DMIMUS, Wardha Dept. of Rachana Sharir, BMAC & RH Butibori, Nagpur. on experimental studies followed by group activity. Day 1 concluded with asking participants to fill feedback form over Google form link.

Day 2 started with lecture on literature search which was conducted by Dr. Shrikant Murlidharan department of public dentistry Madha Dental college & Hopsital Kundrathur Chennai followed by group activity in which participants were divided into groups & each group tried to search references related to topics finalized. Next topic was writing research protocol and ethical issues in medical research were discussed by Dr. Chitra Jai Kini Professor at Dr G D Pol foundation YMT ayurvedic Medical College. After short break the session was handover to Dr. Swati Meshram Prof & head of Dept of musculoskeletal sciences TPCT'S Terna physiotherapy college Nerul Navi Mumbai who enlightened participants knowledge on qualitative research design. 



This year on world cancer day National Virtual conference was organized by the department of Medical Surgical Nursing from 7th to 8th February 2022.

The theme of the conference was Close the care Gap- an overview of evidence based practice in cancer.

A total of 700 candidates participated in the conference pan India, including the Teaching faculties, Nursing officers & Nursing students.

Conference included five plenary sessions & a session on scientific paper presentation.

PROCEEDINGS

OPENING SESSION

Conference was hosted by Ms. Rashmi Tembhurne, Lecturer.




Fig. 01- Participants of National Virtual Conference




Fig. 02-Speaker talk on-Cancer treatment




Fig. 03-Speaker dealing with the topic





Fig. 04- Speaker talk on- Institutional care


