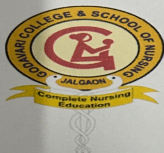



All the students and faculty members are hereby informed that the **International Day of Midwives** will be celebrated in the OBGY Lab on **05 May 2026**.


As part of the celebration, a Demonstration Programme will be conducted by the 7th Semester Students to highlight the important role of midwives in maternal and newborn care.

## **REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL DAY OF MIDWIVES DEMONSTRATION**

Date: 05 May 2026

Venue: OBGY Lab

### **Aim of the Programme**

The aim of the programme was to celebrate the International Day of Midwives and to create awareness among nursing students about the important role of midwives in providing quality maternal and newborn care. The programme also aimed to enhance the practical knowledge, clinical skills, and confidence of 7th semester students through demonstration of obstetrical and newborn care procedures while promoting safe motherhood and healthy childbirth practices.

### **Objectives of the Programme**

To celebrate International Day of Midwives

To create awareness regarding the role of midwives

To improve practical skills of nursing students

To promote safe motherhood and newborn care

To enhance knowledge regarding obstetrical procedures

The International Day of Midwives was celebrated on 05 May 2026 in the OBGY Lab of Godavari College of Nursing, Jalgaon. The programme was organized by the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecological Nursing to recognize and appreciate the vital role of midwives in ensuring safe motherhood and newborn care.

The programme commenced at 11.00 AM with a warm welcome of faculty members and students. The event began with an introduction regarding the importance of the International Day of Midwives and its significance in promoting maternal and child health services across the world. The theme of the programme was also highlighted to create awareness among students regarding the contribution of midwives in society.

The faculty members addressed the students and explained the responsibilities and duties of midwives during antenatal, intranatal, postnatal, and newborn care. Emphasis was given on the importance of skilled birth attendance, prevention of maternal mortality, and quality nursing care during pregnancy and childbirth.

A demonstration programme was conducted by the 7th semester students in the OBGY Lab. Students demonstrated various obstetrical and newborn care procedures using mannequins, charts, and models. ### **Procedures Demonstrated During the Programme**

- Antenatal assessment and abdominal examination
- Preparation of labour room and delivery tray
- Steps of conducting normal vaginal delivery
- Maintenance of aseptic techniques during labour
- Monitoring of mother during labour using partograph
- Immediate care of newborn after birth
- Newborn resuscitation procedure
- Breastfeeding techniques and counselling
- Postnatal assessment and care of mother
- Health education regarding nutrition and hygiene during pregnancy

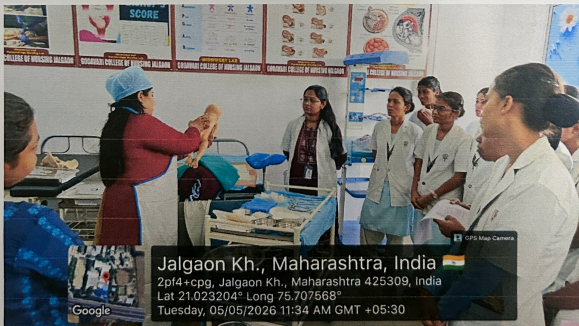

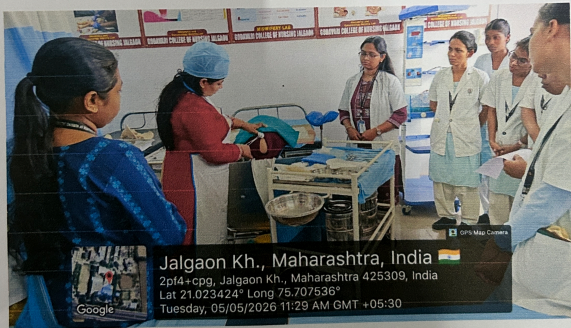

Overall, the celebration of the International Day of Midwives was conducted successfully and provided valuable learning experiences to the students.


