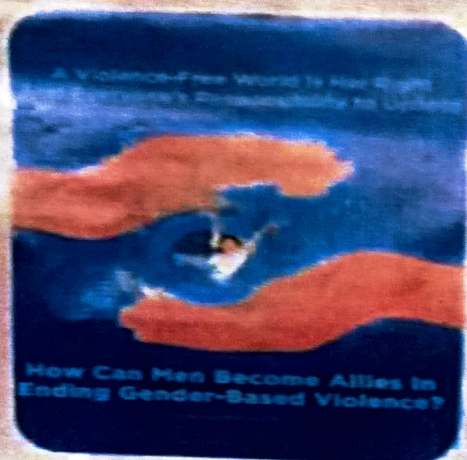

### **MEN'S ROLE IN PREVENTING GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE**

Date: 14 January 2026

#### **INTRODUCTION**

Gender-based violence (GBV) remains a serious social and public health issue affecting individuals, families, and communities. Recognizing the crucial role men play in preventing gender-based violence, an awareness programme titled “Men’s Role in Preventing Gender-Based Violence” was organized to sensitize participants about responsibility, respect, and positive masculinity.

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME**

1. To create awareness among men about gender-based violence and its consequences.
2. To emphasize the role of men as allies in preventing violence against women and girls.
3. To promote respectful attitudes, gender equality, and non-violent behaviour.
4. To encourage men to take active roles in advocacy and community-level prevention.

#### **PROGRAMME PROCEEDINGS**

The programme commenced at 10.00 a.m. with a brief welcome address, highlighting the importance of men’s involvement in ending gender-based violence. This was followed by the introduction of the guest speaker, Dr. Piyush Wagh.



Dr. Piyush Wagh delivered an informative and inspiring session focusing on:

- The concept and types of gender-based violence
- Social and cultural factors contributing to GBV
- The role of men in challenging harmful gender norms
- Importance of communication, respect, and consent
- Ways men can act as role models, supporters, and advocates

Real-life examples and interactive discussions helped participants understand how everyday actions and attitudes of men can either contribute to or prevent gender-based violence.

### **INTERACTION AND DISCUSSION**

An interactive question-and-answer session was conducted, during which participants actively shared their views and clarified doubts. The discussion emphasized:

- Standing against violence
- Speaking up as bystanders
- Supporting victims
- Promoting gender equality in families and society

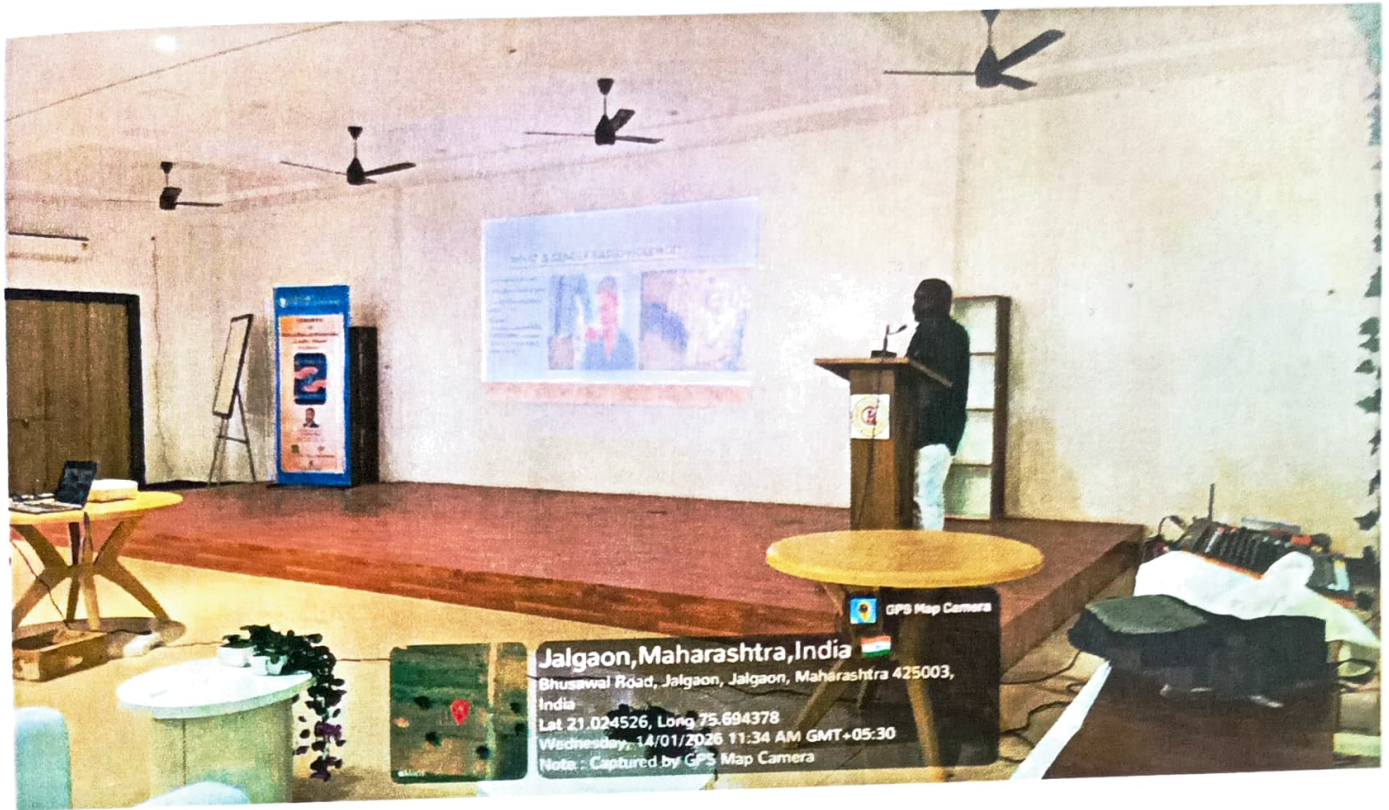
### **OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAMME**

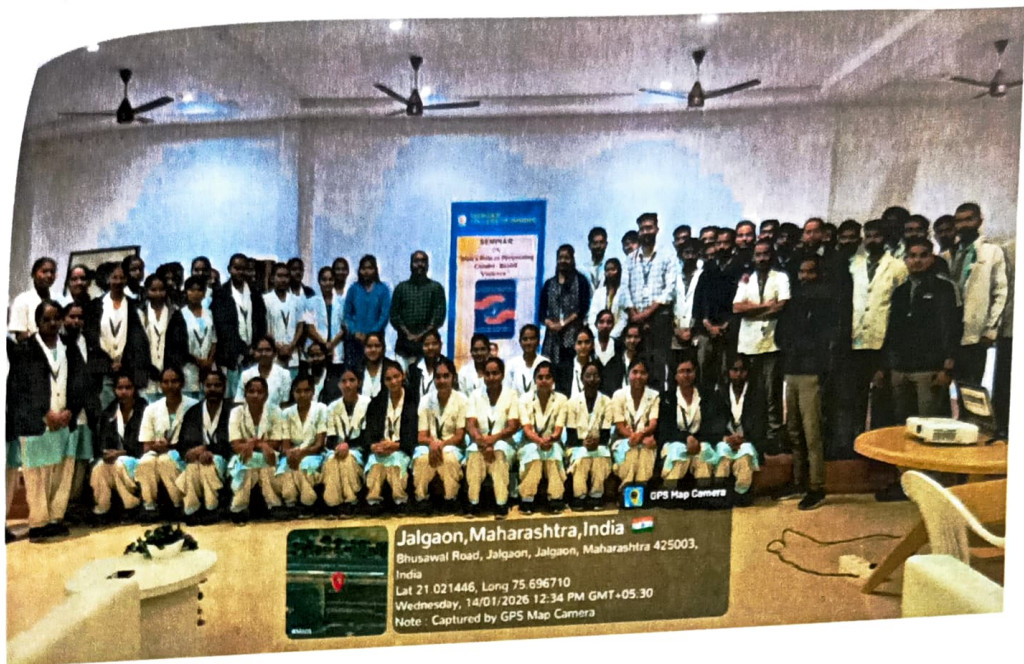


GPS Map Camera
