All the children actively participated and **enjoyed the skit**, making the programme both educational and entertaining.

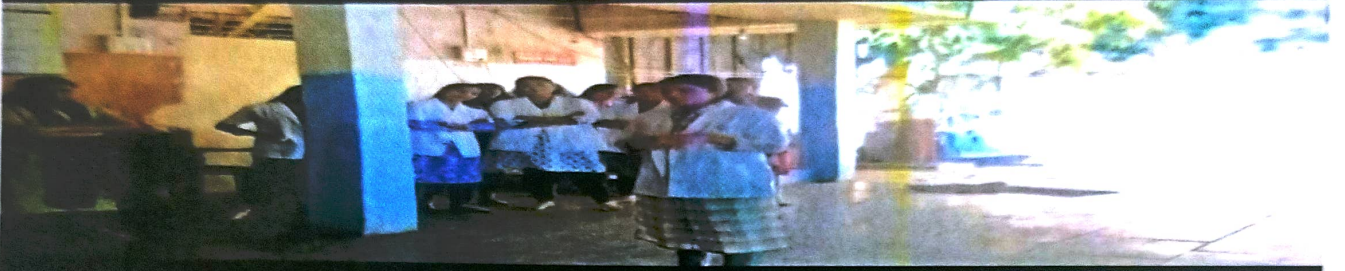
Conclusion
