REPORT

Godavari College of Nursing, Jalgaon organized Anti-Ragging Awareness Week 2026 from 12th to 18th August 2026 under the theme “#YaARI – Youth Against Ragging.” The programme was organized with the aim of creating awareness among students about the harmful effects of ragging and its legal and disciplinary consequences. It also focused on promoting a safe, respectful, friendly, inclusive, and completely ragging-free campus environment. Various educational and creative activities were conducted throughout the week, including the Inauguration Ceremony, Anti-Ragging Pledge, Student Interaction, Slogan Competition, Poster Competition, Anti-Ragging Awareness Rally, Logo Designing Competition, Awareness Video/Short Film Presentation, and Prize Distribution and Valedictory Ceremony.



DAY 1

Inauguration Ceremony and Anti-Ragging Pledge

Date: 12 August 2026 | Time: 9:15 a.m. | Venue: Akshata Patil Hall

The Anti-Ragging Week was inaugurated at Akshata Patil Hall in the presence of students and faculty members. The programme aimed to educate students about the serious consequences of ragging and the importance of maintaining discipline and mutual respect within the institution.

Adv. Shailesh Ravikant Nagla, LL.M., having 13 years of experience in Civil and Criminal Law and six years of teaching experience, was invited to address the students. He provided valuable information regarding the legal aspects of ragging, its consequences, and the responsibilities of students in preventing such incidents.

The students were encouraged to follow the message "Say No to Ragging" and to treat every student with dignity and respect. The Anti-Ragging Pledge was administered to the students, through which they committed themselves to opposing ragging and helping to maintain a safe and supportive campus.







DAY 2

Student Interaction and Awareness Programme

A student interaction session was conducted to create awareness regarding the prevention of ragging and its consequences. Students were encouraged to understand the difference between friendly interaction and activities that may cause humiliation, fear, harassment, or physical and mental distress.

The session emphasized the importance of friendship, cooperation, discipline, equality, and respect between senior and junior students. Students were also encouraged to report any form of ragging and seek appropriate assistance whenever required.

DAY 3

Slogan Competition And Poster Competition "Say No to Ragging"

A Slogan Competition was organized to provide students with an opportunity to express their views creatively on the prevention of ragging. Students prepared meaningful slogans conveying messages of friendship, unity, dignity, respect, equality, and zero tolerance towards ragging.

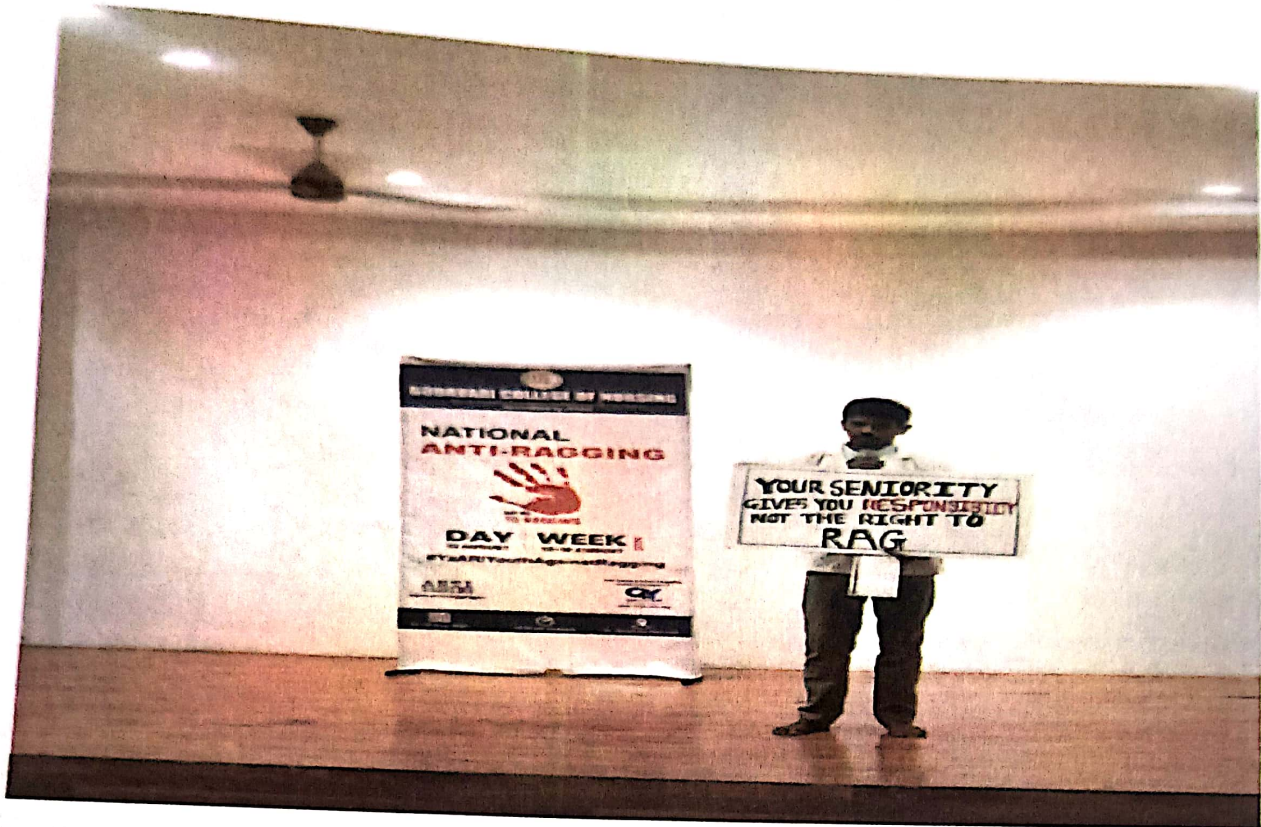


The competition helped students communicate the anti-ragging message in a simple and effective manner and encouraged them to become active contributors to the campaign.

Anti-Ragging Awareness Rally

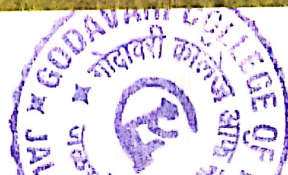
Date: 15 August 2026

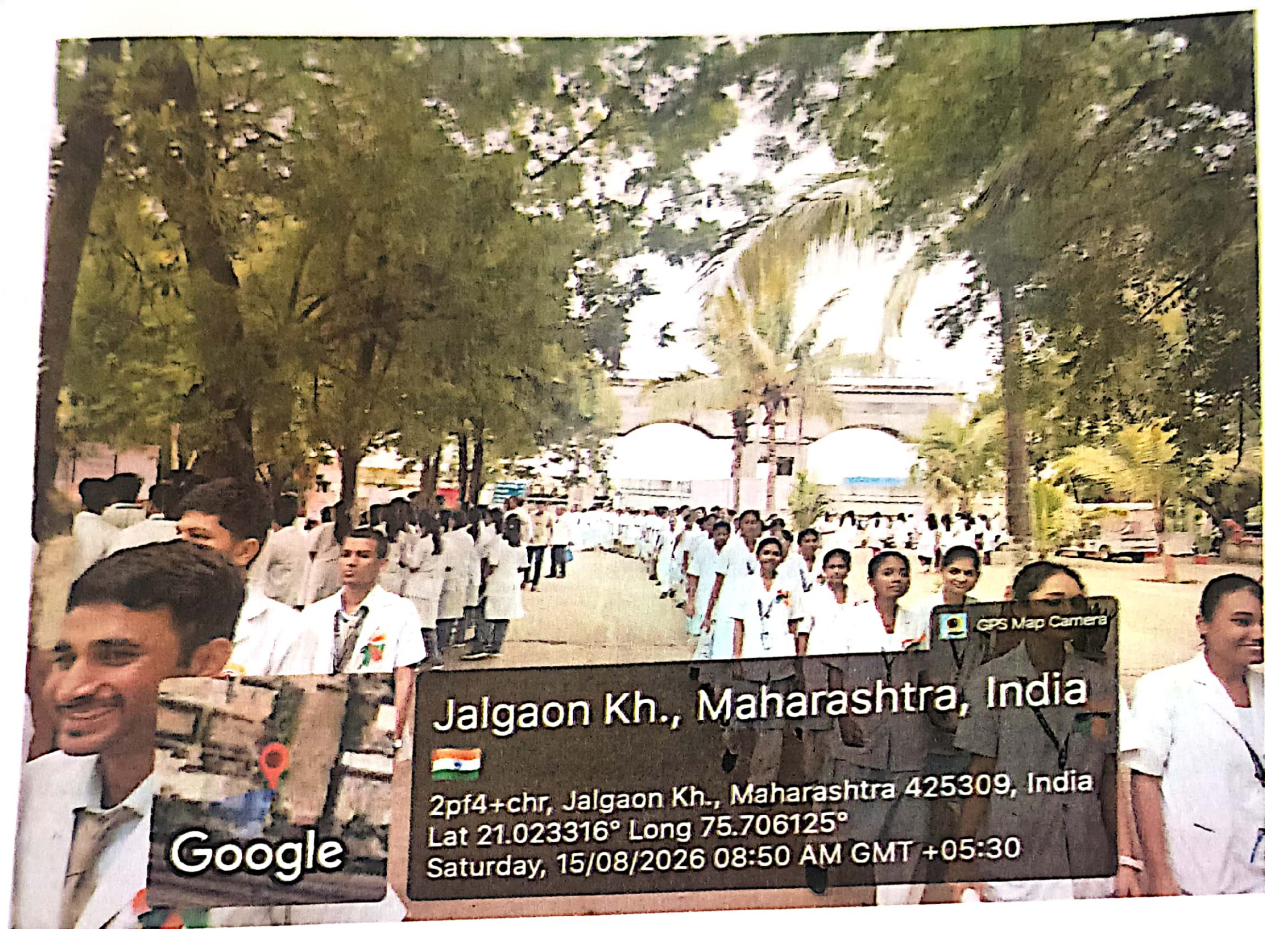

A Logo Designing Competition AND Anti-Ragging Awareness Video / Short Film Presentation

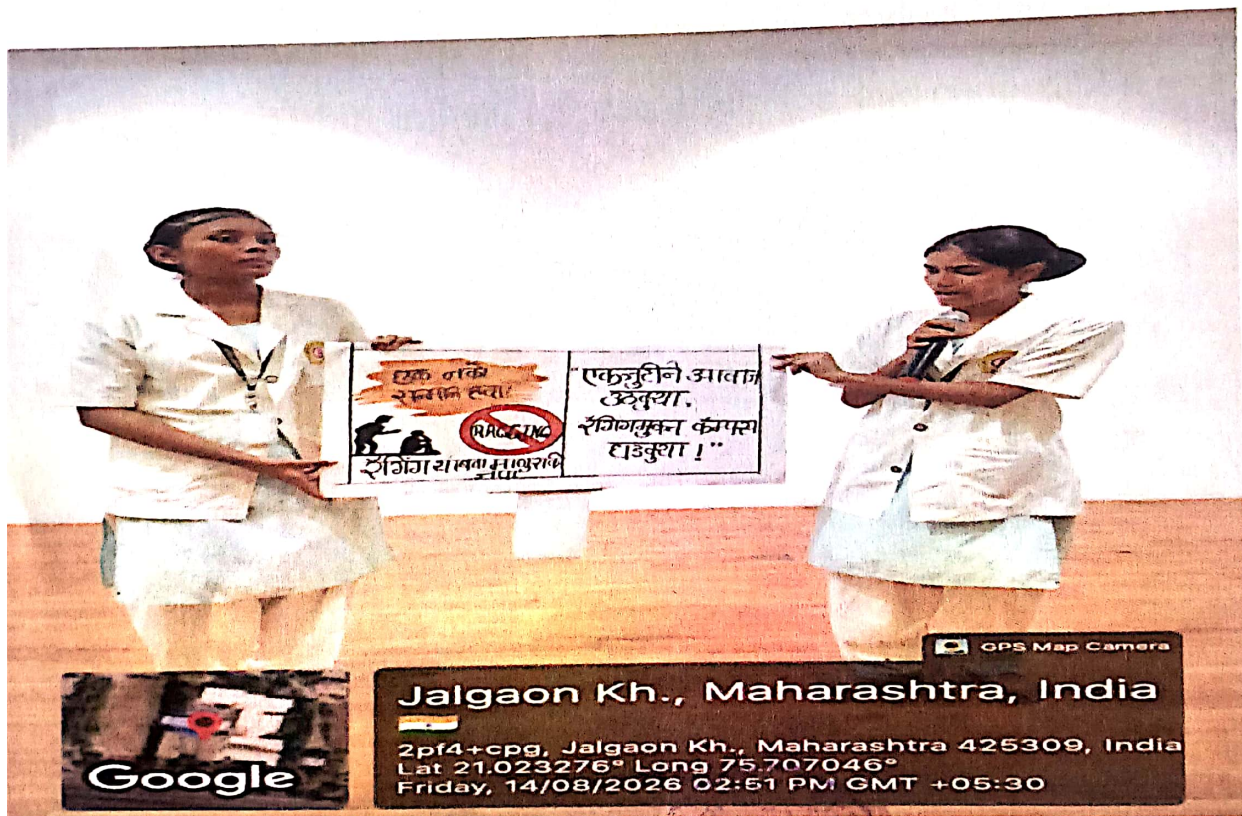
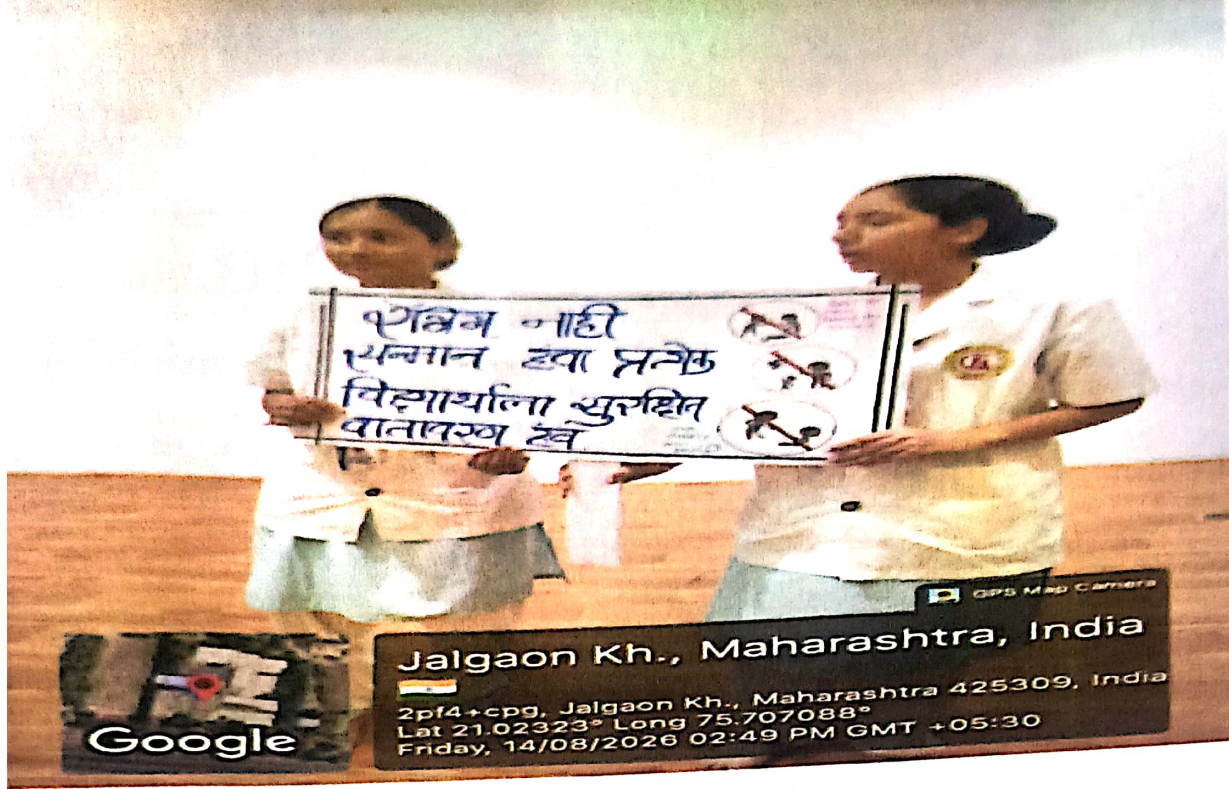
