#### **Course description:**

This course is designed to bring awareness raising, information sharing and motivation building for respectful maternity care (RMC).

Participants will begin to change and develop RMC attitudes in themselves, and learn how to facilitate the implementation of RMC in their workplaces and among colleagues who also provide care to women and their newborns.

This course is offered to the 1<sup>st</sup> year MSc students nurses.

#### **Objectives**

- To explain about abuse and disrespect of mother and newborn
- To promote the need for RMC
- To establish the rights of women in child bearing women.

**Name of the course:** Respectful Maternity Care

**Aim of the course:** To practice respectful maternity care in labour room

**Objectives of the course**
