Day 1: Swachh Bharat Abhiyan (9th September 2024)

The camp kicked off with a cleanliness drive at the Primary Health Centre, Nashirabad. Students actively participated in cleaning efforts, emphasizing the importance of hygiene in public spaces. They also performed an educational skit on breastfeeding, educating the local mothers on best practices and dispelling common myths. Day 2: Self-Defence Training (10th September 2024)

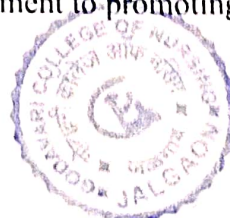

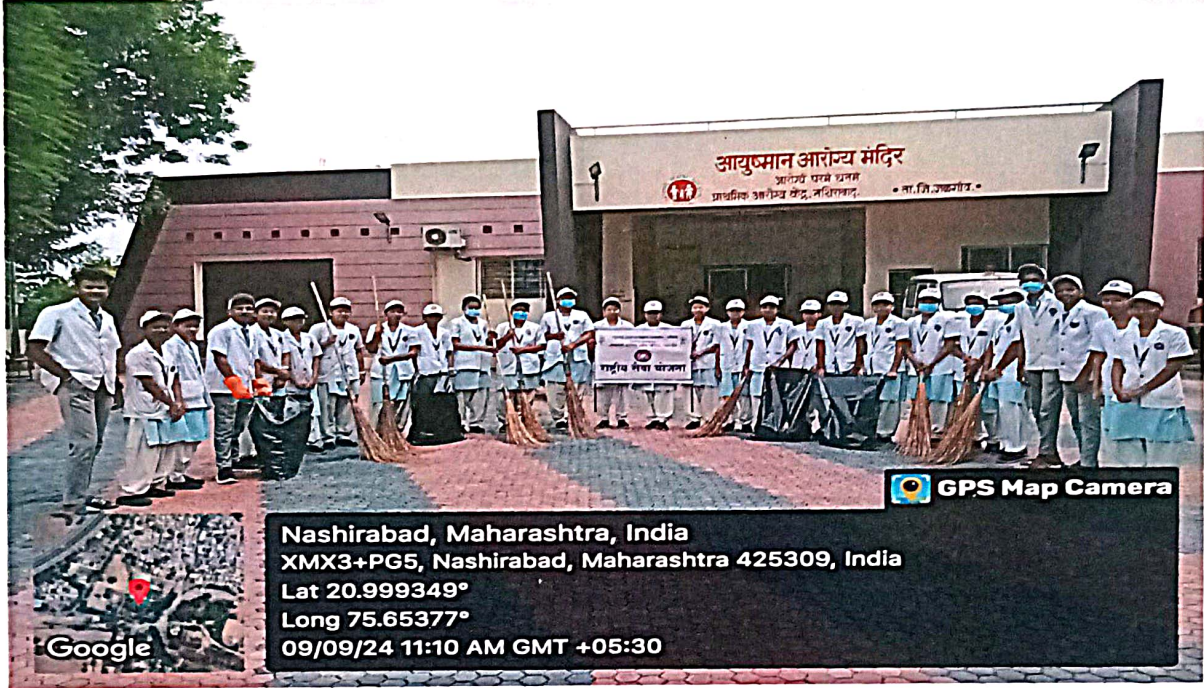
Conclusion

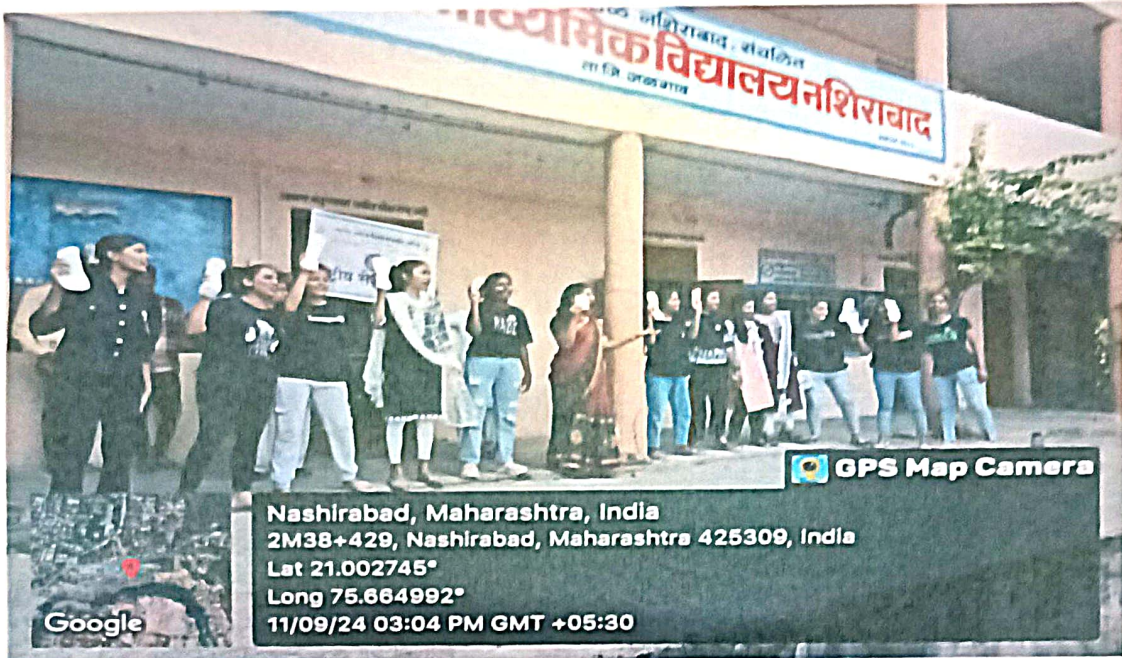
