INTRODUCTION:

A breast self-exam is an early detection tool that uses a combination of physical and visual examinations of the breasts to check for signs and symptoms of breast cancer. The purpose of a breast self-exam is to become familiar with the way your breasts normally look and feel. Knowing how your breasts normally look and feel, also called breast self-awareness, will help you identify any changes or abnormalities in your breasts, such as a new lump or skin changes. Any changes in your breasts discovered during a breast self-exam should be reported to your healthcare provider right away.

AIMS:

- To educate and empower nursing students and teachers to perform and teach breast self-examination effectively, contributing to early detection and better outcomes in breast cancer management.
- To ensure that nursing students and teachers are well-equipped to perform breast self-examinations, educate others, and contribute to early detection and improved breast health outcomes.

MAIN OBJECTIVES:

- Train participants in the proper technique for breast self-examination, emphasizing thoroughness and consistency.
- Share statistics and information on breast cancer incidence, risk factors, and survival rates.
- Provide hands-on practice to enhance the proficiency of participants in performing breast self-examinations.
- Train participants to provide emotional support and information to individuals who may discover a breast abnormality during self-examination.
- Familiarize participants with current clinical guidelines and recommendations related to breast self-examination.
- Highlight the importance of self-care and emotional wellness for nursing students and teachers involved in breast health education and support.

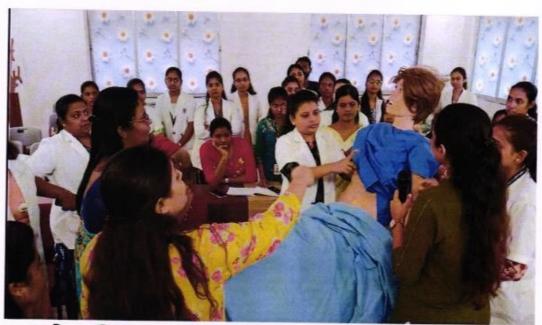
